Council Works

Wycheproof's wetlands have taken shape with the completion of major earthworks. Work on the walking track around the perimeter will commence in the coming weeks.

As part of the 'Lighting Up Buloke' project, support bases have been completed at all six sporting fields across four towns in the district in readiness for the installation of lighting poles. Charlton Park, Donald Tennis Club, and the Nullawil and Wycheproof Recreation Reserves will have greatly expanded hours of use for the eight sporting clubs utilising these facilities and the broader community when completed.

The \$2.15M project is funded by the Victorian Government's Community Sports Infrastructure Stimulus Program.

The new carpark in Charlton's sporting precinct is also ready for sealing following completion of surface preparation works.



Road Maintenance

Resurfacing works across Buloke have commenced and will continue until the end of April. Disruptions to traffic are usually brief and road crews request that road users be patient and considerate for their safety and the safety of other drivers.

Please observe all speed limits and warning signage, as immediately following resurfacing some loose gravel is to be expected.

Easter Waste Collection

Donald and Corack's rural collection bins will be emptied on Thursday instead of Friday over Easter. Waste Management requests these communities to place their bins out on Wednesday evening. Landfills and Transfer Stations will also be closed for Good Friday on 15 April, but will operate normally on Easter Sunday and Monday 17-18 April.

All other services continue unaffected.
