Free Measles Booster Vaccine

Are you eligible for a free measles booster vaccine?

In 2019 there was a dramatic increase in the number of people worldwide who have died or became ill with measles including many cases in Australia, a country once considered measles-free. There are current measles health warnings in place in Western Australia, New South Wales and more than 50 confirmed cases in Victoria.

As well as babies, the most at risk members of the population are those who were born after 1966 or who were born overseas. Due to the rates of measles infections worldwide, it is also important to be up-to-date with your measles vaccine if you will be travelling overseas.

If you are not sure if you have had 2 doses of the measles vaccine, you can attend your GP or any of our public immunisation sessions for a free dose.
