#### **Riverfront** Progress

The Bullock's Head precinct on the Donald riverfront now has a newly sealed carpark with line marking. This adds to the new undercover barbeque and viewing platform completed earlier this year, and is expected to improve the tourist appeal of the unique area during the wetter months.



#### **Streetscape** Oasis

The arbour reserve at the **Wycheproof** Senior Citizens building is taking shape with the vine support structure, seating areas, and period design retaining walls to match the Council building next door nearing completion.

The reserve will form a restful and shady social oasis on the main street, replacing the under-utilised grass area next to the Shire Hall. Work is expected to be completed by the end of August.

#### **Current** Works

Solar bollard lights have been installed on new paths around the **Wycheproof** Wetlands development.

**Sea Lake** streetscape works have recommenced, following delays due to a shortage of qualified tradespeople. Residents and visitors are advised there will be increased truck traffic and worker activity staff in the area.

Housing development demolition works at the old school site on Sutcliff Street have also begun thanks to drier weather. Housing blocks are expected to be ready for sale by the end of the year.

# BECK WASTE CENERAL WASTE

#### **Brainy** Bin

Solar powered, internet connected, sensor activated, using a normal 240 litre Council wheelie bin, this self-contained 'smart bin' measures the height of collected

waste, automatically compacting it when necessary. When approaching full, it then sends a wireless signal to alert Waste Management that emptying is required. These bins can store up to eight times the usual amount of waste.

If installed in remote public areas, the bin only needs emptying when necessary, or more frequently at busy times. Council trialled the Wycheproof unit for eight weeks in 2021, which was gifted to ratepayers by the Loddon Mallee Waste Resource and Recovery Group. Another unit will soon be installed at Lake Tyrrell.
