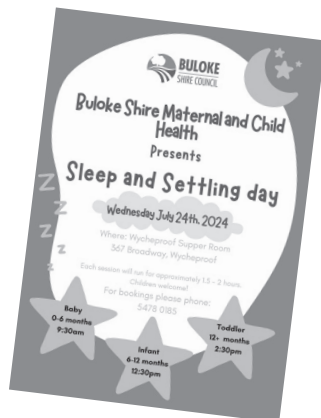

## Sisterhood Project assisting rural families

The Sisterhood Project, founded by sisters Grace and Skye Larson, is a charitable initiative dedicated to providing life-saving training to rural families. CPR and First Aid training was held in the first week of June in Birchip, Donald, Wycheproof, and Sea Lake assisting close to forty families with essential life saving skills. In collaboration with the Buloke Shire Council's Maternal and Child Health Service, these courses also covered respiratory illness recognition, choking response, and farm safety. The Maternal Child Health team at Buloke Shire Council facilitated this crucial partnership, ensuring valuable health and safety education reaches our community, supported by KidsafeWA, Victorian Farmers Federation, and Ambulance Victoria.
