Wycheproof Wetlands Precinct Update

Progress continues at the Wycheproof Wetlands Precinct with the recent installation of pump track modules. Before the site can be opened to the public, additional concreting and landscaping works are necessary to ensure safety and appeal. Alongside this, a new BBQ shelter has been installed, although the BBQ itself still requires connection to the electricity supply before it becomes operational.

The ongoing developments aim to enhance the recreational offerings of the Wycheproof Wetlands, providing a vibrant space for both locals and visitors. These improvements are part of a broader initiative funded by the Regional Tourism Infrastructure Fund. This funding has been made possible by the State Government through Regional Development Victoria, reflecting a commitment to boosting local tourism and community amenities.
