Council to help improve the way our community recycles. You can now take your lightly rinsed empty glass bottles and jars to a local drop off. These glass drop off sites, are located at various places across our Shire:

- Birchip Landfill: 2094 Birchip-Corack RD – Birchip
- Charlton Waste Transfer Station: St Arnaud RD Charlton
- Donald Waste Transfer Station: Depot RD Donald
- Sea Lake Landfill: Robinvale RD Sea Lake
- Wycheproof Waste Transfer Station: 281 Mackies RD Wycheproof

Help make the most of your glass recycling, so that it can be turned into things we can re use... like roads and new glass items. Glass local drop off sites will soon be offered at small townships, and all towns will be having a central drop off point.

BULOKE SHIRE COUNCIL NOTICE OF AN APPLICATION FOR A PLANNING PERMIT

The land affected by the application is located at **332 Goddard Road, Teddywaddy West VIC 3527**. The application is for a permit for the Two lot subdivision of land (rural dwelling excision). The application reference number is **PA24019**. You may view the application and supporting documents on the Buloke Shire Council Website <https://buloke.greenlightopm.com/planning> or by making contact with the office of the Responsible Authority, Buloke Shire Office, Wycheproof on 1300 520 520. This can be done during office hours and is free of charge. Any person who may be affected by the granting of the permit may object or make other submissions to the Responsible Authority. An objection must be made to the Responsible Authority in writing, include the objectors name and contact details, include reasons for the objection, and state how the objector would be affected. An online submission form is available on the Planning page of the Buloke Shire Council website. The Responsible Authority will not decide on the application before **11 July 2024**. If you object to the application, the Responsible Authority will tell you it's decision.

Lighting Up Buloke Sporting Hubs

The final upgrade of the Lighting Up Buloke project is complete, with lights at George Cartwright Oval in Birchip now operational. Funded by the Sport and Recreation Victoria Community Sports Infrastructure Stimulus Program, this project benefits ten local sporting organisations across five towns. Upgrades included lighting at Wycheproof Recreation Reserve, Nullawil Recreation Reserve, Donald Tennis Club, and Charlton Park. Wycheproof received lighting for the main oval, tennis courts, and hockey pitch, while Nullawil's upgrades included netball and football lighting. Donald Tennis Club now has illumination for five courts, and Charlton Park added lights for its hockey pitch, tennis courts, and main oval.
