Cabins Soon Operational in Buloke

Council has made significant progress in the Cabins Infrastructure for Tourism and Short-Term Accommodation Project thanks to the Regional Infrastructure Fund. This initiative involves the registration of seven Caravan Parks and lake campgrounds across Buloke Shire, including crucial upgrades to infrastructure such as firefighting services, and power and water supply enhancements essential for the project's success.

Buloke residents may have noticed cabins emerging in various locations throughout the shire and may be curious about their purpose. These cabins each feature two bedrooms, a bathroom, a living area, and a front verandah. They are also fully compliant with Disability Discrimination Act (DDA) standards, equipped with wheelchair access ramps and adjacent parking. However, the underground infrastructure that is needed to connect the cabins to essential utilities is currently at different stages of completion across each site, requiring coordinated efforts to finalise. Once operational, these cabins will be available to the general public for short-term holiday rentals and seasonal worker accommodation, managed by site-specific committees.
