What are the roles of Councillors?

Councillors serve as community leaders, influencing Council decisions that impact our community. Once elected, they work together with fellow Councillors and staff to shape strategic direction in Buloke and establish policies for community services.

Mandatory Candidate Training

Local Government Victoria and the Victorian Electoral Commission require people to meet certain eligibility criteria in order to become a council election candidate. This includes undertaking a mandatory candidate training session provided by the Victorian Government.

Stand for Council - MAV

Hosted by the Municipal Association of Victoria (MAV), there are two sessions which residents of Buloke Shire Council who are considering nominating as a candidate for the 2024 Council
