Animal Registrations Are Now Overdue

Animal registrations are now overdue. Registering your pets is necessary under the Domestic Animals Act 1994 (Victoria) and is due on 10 April each year.

Registration also greatly improves the chances of your pets being returned to you if they become lost.

Reminders are currently being sent to all pet owners who have not yet registered their pets to avoid infringement notices.

Notice of an Application for a Planning Permit

The land affected by the application is located at **35 Aitken Avenue, Donald.**

The application is for a permit for a **two lot subdivision of land (rural dwelling excision).**

The applicant for the permit is **CardnoTGM.**

The application reference number is **PPA 922/21.**

You may look at the application and any documents that support the application by making contact with the office of the Responsible Authority, **Buloke Shire Office, Wycheproof.**

This can be done during office hours and is free of charge. Any person who may be affected by the granting of the permit may object or make other submissions to the Responsible Authority.

An objection must be sent to the Responsible Authority in writing, include the objectors name and contact details, include reasons for the objection, and state how the objector would be affected. An objection form is available on the Planning and Building page of the Buloke Shire Council website.

The Responsible Authority will not decide on the application before **6 May 2021.**

If you object the Responsible Authority will tell you its decision.
