Dog and Cat Registration

Dog and Cat registrations are payable on 10 April each year under the Domestic Animals Act 1994 (Victoria), however an unavoidable system issue has prevented the release of Council's annual Animal Registration notices and receipt of payments, and these will be delayed.

The payment date on forthcoming annual notices will now be extended to 10 May 2022. Registration will be back-dated to 10 April 2022 in accordance with legislation and all animals will be considered fully registered for 2022. Enforcement action on unregistered dogs and cats will also provide a 30 day grace period due to these technical delays.
