Facility Changes

Streetscaping works are scheduled for **Charlton** this week, commencing with an upgrade to create coloured pavements around the Traveller's Rest amenities building. The building is closed until 30 August 2022 with portable male, female and disabled toilets placed near the playground area in the interim.

The bus stop at the building has also been temporarily relocated further into the carparking area.

Additional toilets in front of the Council precinct at the corner of High Street will be kept open continuously for the duration of the works.

Council also advises that the **Nullawil Silo Art carpark** will be closed for surface upgrading from this week.



Vaping Reminder

Electronic cigarettes (e-cigarettes) are devices which heat and vaporise liquids for inhalation, simulating cigarette smoking. The habit is referred to as 'vaping'. The laws in Victoria treat vaping the same as tobacco, regardless of whether vapourising uses the addictive drug nicotine or not.

Council Health reminds the community that areas **where smoking is banned, vaping is also currently banned**. Council is working to update relevant signage for community guidance across Buloke.

Restricted areas include within 4 metres of any school, kinder or childcare centre; sporting venues where children are playing and all playgrounds; shelters for public transport, or inside a motor vehicle transporting those under 18 years.

Council officers monitor and report compliance of suppliers of tobacco and vaping products to the State Government each year from their Local Government Area. In addition, Council has the authority to issue fines for breaches.

Buloke encourages community advice of any breaches for the health and safety of our community, especially those under 18.
