Parking Reminder

When the weather is wet the impacts of motorists parking incorrectly really does start to show. Parking on nature strips causes surface damage, as well as to trees and root systems, kerb and channel, paths, house drain connections and other underground services.

When parking in the street remember to also park facing the direction of travel for parallel parks and facing into the curb for angle parks.

Residents are reminded that breaches of Victoria's Road Safety Rules 2017 can attract fines.

Council is responding to a large number of community reports of water over roads prompting road closures to ensure safety.

Road users are advised not to drive around road closure signs. Remember if it is flooded – forget it! Do not drive through floodwater and use common sense and avoid dirt roads after a weather event, if possible. Always drive to conditions. Road closures are there to ensure road user safety.
