A FREE service has commenced across Buloke Shire Council to help improve the way our community recycles. You can now take your lightly rinsed empty glass bottles and jars to a local drop off. These glass drop off sites, are located at various places across our Shire:

- **Birchip Landfill:** 2094 Birchip-Corack RD – Birchip
- **Charlton Waste Transfer Station:** St Arnaud RD Charlton

- **Donald Waste Transfer Station:** Depot RD Donald
- **Sea Lake Landfill:** Robinvale RD Sea Lake
- **Wycheproof Waste Transfer Station:** 281 Mackies RD Wycheproof

Help make the most of your glass recycling, so that it can be turned into things we can re-use... like roads and new glass items. Glass out sites will soon be offered at small townships, and all towns will be having a central drop off point.

Free Green Waste to Assist in Storm Clean Up

Council continues to open its landfills and transfer stations to accept green waste free of charge following the storm that hit large parts of Buloke on 13 February 2024.

The storm left a significant amount of damage and fallen trees right across the Shire as well as disrupting essential services.

Free disposal of green waste is now available at each site until the end of March to assist the community in cleanup efforts.

Yeungroon Road Closure for Flood Repair

Repair works will soon begin on the Yeungroon Creek floodway on Yeungroon Road after being damaged in the October 2022 flood and storm event. These works will include the road pavement and surfacing which will be replaced over the course of 6 weeks, beginning **12 March 2024**.

To ensure community safety, a temporary road closure will be in place during this time along Yeungroon Road between Seven Mile Road and Nine Mile Road.

Buloke Playspaces Trail

Council is pleased to provide an update on ongoing playspaces trail projects across Berriwillock, Birchip, Donald and Wycheproof.

In Berriwillock, irrigation work will commence in mid-March, followed by grass and plant installation in late March/early April. The basketball area shelter is set for installation by mid-April, with the rebound wall and basketball court slab to follow shortly after.

In Birchip, irrigation and pool fencing will begin this week, with landscaping and furniture installation slated for early April and the water play area equipment delivery is expected in mid-late June.

In Donald, concrete paths are underway around the BBQ shelter, with further work to connect to the playground next week.

Wycheproof will see concreters starting on remaining footpaths in early March, with irrigation and landscaping to follow. Final play equipment and signage will be installed upon path completion.
