NOTICE OF AN APPLICATION FOR A PLANNING PERMIT

The land affected by the application is located at **4-6 Jenkins Street, Charlton VIC 3525**.

The application is for a permit for a Two lot subdivision of land (boundary realignment).

The application reference number is **PA24007**. This can be done during office hours and is free of charge. Any person who may be affected by the granting of the permit may object or make other submissions to the Responsible Authority.

An objection must be made to the Responsible Authority in writing, include the objectors name and contact details, include reasons for the objection, and state how the objector would be affected. An online submission form is available on the Planning page of the Buloke Shire Council website.

The Responsible Authority will not decide on the application before **28 March 2024**.

If you object to the application, the Responsible Authority will tell you it's decision.
