NEW KERBSIDE COLLECTION TRIAL

Council is preparing to launch a Trial Kerbside Collection service in Sea Lake, Nandaly and Berriwillock, making it easier for township residents to dispose of bulky and accepted items.

As part of the trial, residents will be able to place eligible items at their kerbside for collection, where materials will then be sorted for recycling or appropriate disposal.

The trial will include four key waste streams:

- E-waste
- Mattresses
- Furniture
- Scrap metal

While open to all residents in these towns, the service is expected to be particularly beneficial for those who find it difficult to transport items to one of Council's five waste transfer stations.

Council currently provides access to five waste facilities operating across much of the week.

However, Council recognises that disposing of larger items can still present challenges for some community members.

The Waste team is excited to roll out this trial in late June.

Insights gathered from the northern Shire will help inform the feasibility of introducing an ongoing kerbside collection service across all Buloke Shire townships.

If you live in Sea Lake, Nandaly or Berriwillock, keep an eye out for further details soon including accepted items, collection routes and schedules.
