



## CAREERS AT COUNCIL

Buloke Shire staff recently joined local businesses at the North Central Trade Training Centre (NCTTA) VET Taster Day and Careers Event, held at the Charlton Stadium.

Staff engaged with students from across the region, including Buloke and Loddon shires, sharing insights into career pathways within local government and the wider workforce.

## WATCHUPGA ROADWORKS

Road rehabilitation works on Watchupga West Rd. are set to commence in the coming weeks involving reconstruction and repair of Council road infrastructure damaged by the various flood events over the past four years.

The project involves the reconstruction of approximately 550 linear meters of Watchupga West Rd., north of the Tagliabue Rd. intersection at Watchupga.

As part of the reconstruction, the 4m wide road pavement will be repaired providing safety and accessibility for road users. The project will also include the reconstruction of 1.5m wide crushed rock shoulders on both sides of the road and reform of the existing swale drains.

The rehabilitation of Watchupga West Road involves reusing materials from the current pavement by recycling and reusing existing pavement where possible.

The result being a reconstructed pavement, re-sealed and repaired drainage infrastructure returning the road to functional and safe condition for the community.

## BERRIWILLOCK ROADWORKS

Road rehabilitation works are set to commence in the coming weeks on Berriwillock Woomelang Rd., Willangie Woomelang Rd. and Berriwillock Springfield Rd. to repair and reconstruct road infrastructure damaged by the various flood events over the past four years.

The project involves the reconstruction of approximately 740m of Berriwillock Woomelang Rd., 200m of Willangie Woomelang Rd. and 800m of Berriwillock Springfield Rd.

In addition to pavement reconstruction, the works will include the construction of 1.5m crushed rock shoulders on both sides of the road and the reformation of existing swale drains to improve drainage.

As part of the project, the reconstructed sections of Berriwillock Woomelang Rd and Berriwillock Springfield Rd will be widened from the existing 4m pavement to a 6.2m pavement. These improvements will provide safer and more reliable travel conditions for residents, landowners, and other road users.

- Construction contract awarded to Harril Pty Ltd / Coburns Earthmoving
- Works expected to be completed by 18 September 2026 (weather permitting)
- Traffic management in place during construction
- Road users must follow signage, speed limits and traffic controls
- Council appreciates cooperation of residents, landowners and road users

The Responsible Authority will not decide on the application before **9 July 2026**.

If you object to the application, the Responsible Authority will tell you it's decision.
