# WHAT DO I NEED TO DO?

Go to the *Streatrader* website – https://streatrader.health.vic.gov.au You will be directed to Business Victoria Online, where you will create your login (unless you already have one, in which case you just simply fill in your username and password). Once your login details are complete you will automatically enter the *Streatrader* website. Now you are ready to complete your forms. *Streatrader* will guide you through the process until you're ready to hit the lodge button.

Please remember that you will need to comply with any roadside trading or planning laws in the council where you plan to trade.

# ARE YOU A COMMUNITY GROUP SELLING FOOD?

It may be a fundraising event like a cake stall or sausage sizzle where the food is sold or handled from temporary and mobile tents, vans or community halls.

Community groups and clubs, and voluntary associations that sell food to raise funds, are now required to register with just one principal council. Once this is done, the community group can operate anywhere in Victoria. All you need to do is lodge a Statement of Trade with councils about where and when you are selling food.

# WHAT IS STREATRADER?

Registration and notification of your community group's food selling activity is about to become easier with the launch of *Streatrader*, a new website that allows you to complete forms online with one principal council. Your principal council is where you:

- 1. Prepare food before trading; or
- 2. Store food before trading

If you don't do either of these, your principal council is where you:

- 3. Store equipment for your stall or tent; or
- 4. Garage your vehicle

### WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS?

### Simple

All the forms you need to fill in are now available online. *Streatrader* will guide you through the process. It will even identify your principal council.

### Efficient

When your online application to register or notify is accepted by your principal council, you can trade anywhere in Victoria, provided you lodge a Statement of Trade in *Streatrader*.

### Convenient

Being online means you can log in anywhere, anytime, and lodge or update your forms, or contact details.
