Funding announced for Sea Lake facilities

Funding has been announced for the extension of the existing Netball/Tennis courts, resurfacing new area with acrylic surface, upgrading the court lighting and the installation of compliant court drainage at the Sea Lake/Nandaly Football Netball Club.

The Member for Northern Victoria, Steve Herbert, announced a \$100,000 Country Football Netball grant on Friday 15 April. This gives Sea Lake/Nandaly Football Netball Club the opportunity to update tired facilities and build the club they need.
