Maternal and Child Health Service Update

Buloke Shire Council's Maternal and Child Health Service has undergone some recent minor changes that do not impact on the services provided.

Buloke Shire Council's Maternal and Child Health Service provides ten free Key Ages and Stages medical consultations for all families with babies and young children, from birth to three and a half years of age.

Buloke, like most rural shires, is experiencing ongoing lower birth rates which has required some restructuring to our service delivery. Services will continue to be provided to all service users.

The service will continue to be provided at the following Buloke Shire Maternal and Child Health Centres on the following days of each week:

- Monday Sea Lake
- Tuesday Birchip
- Wednesday Charlton
- Thursday Donald
- Friday Wycheproof

Both home and centre visits are available. Appointment is the preferred method.
