Some preparatory activities undertaken by Buloke Shire Council today include:

- Removed the boards from the Charlton Weir
- Currently stockpiling soil at Camp Street in Donald to manage the gaps in the Donald levee
- Some drainage works around Jubilee Street in Wycheproof
- Council has moved machinery, organised signs, sought the availability of earthmoving contractors and is scheduling staff over the weekend

• A generator is ready to be set up at the Charlton Hall tomorrow, which is where a recovery centre would be activated if needed

- Sandbag machine has been tested in Charlton today.
- Sand loads delivered to depot sites.

Council will endeavour to maintain services as normal during these times but history tells us to expect disruptions to services and road access. Monitor Council's social media for updates.

Never walk, ride or drive through floodwater, Never allow children to play in floodwater, Stay away from waterways and stormwater drains during and after heavy rain, Keep well clear of fallen power lines Be aware that in fire affected areas, rainfall run-off into waterways may contain debris such as ash, soil, trees and rocks, and heavy rainfall increases the potential for landslides and debris across roads.
