## Wycheproof Solar Information Meeting

For anyone thinking about 'going solar' or adding battery storage on their home or business, there's an opportunity to learn more at a community information meeting in the Wycheproof Shire Hall Supper Room on **Wednesday 24 March between 6.00-7.30pm.** 

Hosted by the not-for-profit Central Victorian Greenhouse Alliance — and in partnership with Central Goldfields Shire Council — this meeting will provide attendees with the information they need to decide whether now's a good time to get solar installed or to invest in a battery.

Presenters are from solar & battery bulk-buy — Mallee Sun Solar Bulk-Buy — which is owned and organised by the Central Victorian Greenhouse Alliance.

Mallee Sun Solar Bulk-Buy aims to encourage the uptake of more solar in the region, helping residents cut their electricity bills and reduce CO2 emissions. Community groups benefit with one percent of bulk-buy revenues distributed to not-for-profit groups in each shire in the form of free solar.
