
COMMUNITY UPDATE

Wood Heater Smoke

Council is reminding residents to use their wood heaters efficiently in order to help reduce air pollution. They are a great source of winter-warmth however problems can arise if they are not operated correctly.

A number of residents have already contacted Council concerned about the amount of smoke that is being generated by wood heaters this winter. Council is encouraging people with wood heaters to follow a few simple steps before operating their wood heater.

To reduce pollution from wood heaters, be sure to purchase a wood heater that is certified to the Australian Standard and installed by a licensed person.

Have your flue professionally checked and cleaned before each winter and maintain visuals checks.

Refer to the manufacturer's operation manual, burn only dry, seasoned, untreated wood and get the fire going quickly.

Never overload your wood heater with too much wood or leave it to smoulder overnight.

Consider the wellbeing of your neighbours.

If you live in town and are thinking of a wood heater for your home, consider natural gas instead. Gas heaters produce less pollution than wood heaters.

Council encourages residents affected by smoke from wood fire heaters on neighbouring properties to attempt to resolve the issue amicably however if further intervention is required, you may contact Council's Public Health Officer to discuss your concerns.
