# Mayor's Message - R U OK?

Next Thursday 9 September is R U OK? Day, the national day of action dedicated to reminding everyone that every day is the day to ask, "Are you OK?" and support those struggling with life's ups and downs.

We are no stranger to emergencies and testing times like droughts and floods in Buloke Shire. Every day stresses are now being exacerbated by the COVID-19 pandemic. As the restrictions ease and tighten, it can be really difficult to understand how you are tracking yourself, let alone those around you.

Supporting people can make a real difference whatever they may be facing.

So, don't wait until someone's visibly distressed or in crisis. Make a moment meaningful and ask them how they're really going.

You may have that gut feeling that someone you know or care about it isn't behaving as they normally would. Perhaps they seem out of sorts? More agitated or withdrawn? Or they're just not themselves. Trust that gut instinct and act on it.

Remember, before you can look out for others, you need to look out for yourself.

Are you in a good place? Are you willing to genuinely listen? Can you give as much time as is needed?

Make sure you are prepared for the answers that might come when you ask RU OK? Are you prepared for them to tell you they are not tracking so well? You also need to understand they may not be ready to talk or may not want to talk to you about it, even though you are coming from the right place.

Pick your moment well.

Choose a comfortable, quiet space to ask R U OK?

Make sure it is a good time for them to chat and that you have enough time to chat properly.

Ready to ask R U OK?

Be relaxed, open with easy questions like "How are you going?"

Listen with an open mind. Take what they say seriously and don't interrupt or rush the conversation.

Encourage action. Ask what they may have done in similar situations, or how you can support them.

Remember to check back in. Pop a reminder in your diary to call them in a couple of weeks. If they're really struggling, follow up with them sooner.

Are they really OK? Ask them today. Your conversation could change a life.
