


Beat The Bite Campaign

With humid and stormy weather predicted ahead, it's important to remember to protect yourself and your family from mosquito-borne disease.

Mosquitoes need water to breed. Heavy rains and flash flooding coupled with warmer temperatures can bring mosquitoes. The best protection from mosquito-borne diseases is to avoid mosquito bites.

Mozzies can bite through tight clothing, so it's best to cover up and wear long, loose-fitting clothing, as well as using mosquito repellents containing picaridin or DEET on all exposed skin. Always check the insect repellent label for advice regarding application on children.

Small Towns Big Difference Program - Register for Information Sessions

The Program aims to assist community organisations undertake smaller community-based projects, which champion social outcomes.

It was developed recognizing that many funding programs are more often geared towards economic development rather than the social benefits of small communities. Consequently, some community organisations find it difficult to attract funding for their smaller community-based projects.

This Program focuses on building community capacity, social inclusion, community pride, improved lifestyle and access to community services, along with projects that develop the local economy.

It recognises the importance of community groups and volunteers as an essential part of Buloke, in strengthening the community, and creating opportunities to continue to create meaningful change.

The \$120,000 fund is a collaboration between Council, the Mallee Regional Partnership, Charlton and Donald Community Banks and the Bendigo and Adelaide Bank.

Notice of an Application for a Planning Permit

The land affected by the application is located at **11 Corack Road, Wycheproof.**

The application is for a permit for the **use and development of land for a dwelling.**

The application reference number is **PPA967/21.**
