Brightening Broadway

All major works within the civic park are now complete as part of the Wycheproof Streetscape Renewal Project, funded by the Victorian Department of Jobs, Precincts and Regions.

The civic park, opposite the Council Offices, was opened to the public over the New Year break and features updated footpaths and crossovers, furniture and shelter installations, greening of the street, artwork, signage, an EV charger and new lighting.

Disability Support Network

NOTICE OF INTERRUPTION TO THE PUBLIC LIBRARIES VICTORIA INTER LIBRARY LOANS SERVICE

The Buloke Shire Council Library services operates as a part of Public Libraries Victoria, utilising the Inter-library loans network from across the Victorian library network.

Since the end of October 2022, this service has been suspended for all libraries due to changes to the courier services previously utilised.

Unfortunately, a solution to resolve the issue and reinstate a courier service has not yet been reached, therefore library users within Buloke currently may NOT request any items from other external library services until further notice.

We encourage users to continue to utilise the local Buloke library resources as well as our online resources via Borrow Box

Buloke Sustainability Grants

Community Sustainability Grants are open to community groups needing financial assistance for a project which reduce their carbon footprint, improves the environment, conserves resource usage, or provides sustainability education.

This financial year, Buloke offers two types of sustainability grants: General Sustainability Grant program; and a new 'Quick Action' Sustainability Grant program.

The Quick Action program is for funding up to \$2,000, with no co-contribution, enabling community groups to undertake smaller sustainability projects easier.

Applications are considered on a rolling basis, until the funding pools are expended.

Flood Grants

One-off \$5000 grants are available under the Small Business Immediate Flood Relief Program or the Community Sport Emergency Flood Assistance Program, to provide immediate support. Applications for these grants will close on Tuesday 7 February.

Further funding is available to eligible applicants under the Business and Community Sport Flood Recovery Grants program.

The Flood Recovery Grants provide up to \$50,000 (excl. GST) to help cover eligible expenses incurred from direct damage due to flooding. Funding received under the Small Business Immediate Flood Relief Program, or the Community Sport Emergency Flood Assistance Program will be included in the total grant amount. Currently, applicants must first have been successful for the \$5000 one-off grant before applying for the \$50,000 grant. Applications for these grants close on 1 May 2023.

Concessional loans of up to \$250,000 are available to small businesses and not-for-profit organisations that have suffered significant damage to their assets and/or significant loss of income. The loans are for restoring or replacing damaged assets and/or to meet working capital expenses.

The free **Business Relief Service** provides confidential one-on-one support from local Business Relief Advisers via phone and on the ground. Businesses can register online, or call the Business Victoria hotline on 13 22 15.

Mental health and wellbeing support is available to sole traders, business owners and their employees can call the Partners in Wellbeing Helpline on 1300 375 330 for free and confidential advice, available seven days a week.
