## Roadside Slashing Program has Started

Council has commenced the 2023 Spring Roadside Slashing Program.

Grass will be cut along 2,093 km of our road network and Council has awarded TMC Enviro of Birchip the contract to undertake these works.

The slashing program is scheduled to finish in mid November.

Council will monitor weather patterns throughout the program, and if required, a second treatment is likely in early autumn 2024.

To assist with road safety matters, TMC Enviro will have traffic management in place during these works. This safety protocol is in place to alert all road users of these works.

A kindly reminder, please keep an eye out for roadside slashing works and obey all road signage to keep everyone safe.

## Notice Application for a Planning Permit

An objection must be made to the Responsible Authority in writing, include the objectors name and contact details, include reasons for the objection, and state how the objector would be affected. An online submission form is available on the Planning page of the Buloke Shire Council website.

The Responsible Authority will not decide on the application before **9 November 2023.**

If you object to the application, the Responsible Authority will tell you it's decision.
