



FLOOD DAMAGE REPAIRS

In 2010 and 2011 Buloke Shire suffered two major flood events, with each event causing significant damage to Council's road infrastructure.



PET REGISTRATIONS

Pet registration renewals are due by **10 April 2014**. If your cat or dog is over the age of three months, it must be registered with Council.

If you have ever lost a family pet you will know what a difference pet registration can make. It gives you a better chance of being reunited with your pet if it goes missing. Registration renewal forms will be sent to pet owners this month. If you have not received one, please contact Council's Local Laws Team on **1300 520 520**. Failure to register your animal by the due date may result in a \$289 fine.

All dogs and cats registered for the first time must be microchipped and all cats must be desexed.

Cats owned by breeders who are registered with an approved association are exempt.

VEGETATION MANAGEMENT WORKS UNDER POWERLINES

Buloke Shire and Powercor have developed a draft works program to identify trees growing under powerlines that are deemed a safety risk, and which require pruning and in some cases removal.

Powercor is responsible for pruning and removal works on public land in all townships within the Buloke Shire and within boundaries of all private properties. They are required to maintain the clearing spaces around powerlines in accordance with the Electricity Safety (Electric Line Clearance) Regulations 2010.

Energy Safe Victoria is the government agency responsible for electrical safety issues and ensures electricity companies meet their responsibilities under the code.

The draft works program is an agreement with Buloke Shire and Powercor that outlines responsibilities, agreed actions and future management of trees under powerlines.

Powercor will be carrying out management works in the Buloke Shire over the coming months and works will be conducted in consultation with Council. Works that will be carried out in the towns will be advertised in local papers prior to the commencement of any works being undertaken.

Affected customers will be notified of all private tree works at the time of inspection and prior to clearing.
