COMMUNITY SUSTAINABILITY GRANTS – STILL OPEN!

If you have a project or idea that contributes to reducing your community's carbon footprint, improve the environment or effectively conserve resource usage you might be eligible to apply for a Community Sustainability Grant of up to \$10,000.

Here are some ideas to get you started:

- Energy upgrades – install solar panels, switch to LED lighting, improve insulation in halls or sheds
- Electrification – replace gas heaters, stoves or hot water systems with efficient electric alternatives
- Energy efficiency – upgrade appliances (fridges, tools, air conditioners) to reduce power use and costs
- Waste reduction – introduce recycling stations, composting systems or reusable kitchen supplies
- Water savings – rainwater tanks, low-flow fixtures or garden irrigation upgrades
- Greener spaces – plant shade trees, native gardens or create community green areas.
