Great Court Coverage

More great news for the Birchip sporting precinct with the announcement of \$200,000 of funding from the Victorian Government's 2020-21 Local Sports Infrastructure Fund — Female Friendly Facilities

The Birchip-Watchem Netball Club will benefit from the investment with their two asphalt courts set to be converted into acrylic surfaces, addressing a range of safety issues.

The \$300,000 project is also funded by the Drought Communities Programme -Buloke Drought Resilience and Response Program (Round 2) with works set to commence later in the year.
