Water Rebate

Impacted during the flood event? Rebates are assessed on a case-by-case basis by the relevant area water authority of your area. Give them a call.

- One-off water bill rebates applicable to both residential and commercial properties
- \$600 rebate for properties which were affected by flooding above floor level
- \$300 rebate for properties affected by flood but not with above floor level inundation

Contact your local water authority to confirm eligibility and rebate amount.

Illegal Dumping

We would just like to give a big thank you on behalf of our whole community to those who report illegal dumping. It's such a burden on the ratepayer and your help by reporting suspected illegal dumping is helping to reduce costs.

Whether it's furniture, trash or building rubble, everyone has encountered illegal waste dumping. Some see it as an inconvenience, but illegal dumping:

- damages our environment (eg. contaminated soil, fire risk)
- is a health risk
- is expensive to manage.

In Victoria, it is illegal to dump or bury waste at a location that isn't licensed to accept it, including private land. Learn more at Environmental Projection Authority (EPA) – www.epa.vic.gov.au

If you suspect illegally dumped contaminated waste, report it to EPA online or by calling 1300 372 842 For dumped household waste, contact Council on 1300 520 520.

If you are nervous about reporting, know that you can lodge a report anonymously.
