

Maintaining Buloke's Road Networks

Council remains committed to uphold the condition of the 4,300 kilometres of gravel sealed roads, especially as we approach the hot and dry months of the year. Council deploys 6 graders throughout the Shire year-round as well as water trucks, roller trucks, and specialised vehicles to combat the impact of weather and keep our roads in optimal condition.

Demonstrating our commitment to sustained road maintenance, Council has allocated \$5.5 million in the 2023-24 budget for capital improvements across the road network and \$6 million in maintenance. This funding aims to preserve the integrity of the road network throughout Buloke and to continue Council's commitment to preserving the quality and safety of our road network into 2024.

Maternal And Child Health Service
