The design of the Baileys Road - Calder Highway intersection upgrade at the Lake Tyrrell viewing area has been released by Regional Roads Victoria.

The intersection will be moved away from the long bend to an open, straight section to improve visibility for approaching vehicles. The highway will be widened to create space for heavier traffic and a dedicated turning lane will be added. Upgrades to safety barriers and new signage are included in the works, expected to be completed in early 2023. Access to the Lake Tyrrell viewing area will remain open.
