Free Green Waste to Assist in Storm Clean Up

Council has immediately opened its landfills and transfer stations to accept green waste free of charge following the storm that hit large parts of Buloke on 13 February 2024. The storm has left a significant amount damage and fallen trees right across the Shire as well as disrupting essential services.

Free disposal of green waste is now available at each site until the end of March to assist the community in clean up efforts.

Yeungroon Road Closure for Flood Repair

Repair works will soon begin on the Yeungroon Creek floodway on Yeungroon Road after being damaged in the October 2022 flood and storm event. These works will include the road pavement and surfacing which will be replaced over the course of 6 weeks, beginning 26 February 2024.

To ensure community safety, a temporary road closure will be in place during this time along Yeungroon Road between Seven Mile Road and Nine Mile Road.
