Charlton Early Years Centre is GO, with the doors opening Tuesday 15 June 2021 at the new Armstrong Street facility.

The \$1.175 million project is funded by the Victorian School Building Authority as part of their Children's Facilities Capital Program.

Designed with significant input from key stakeholders, the new facility has the capacity to deliver kindergarten, childcare and maternal and child health services.

The centre will be officially opened in coming months.

Council has been made aware of unlicensed re-stumpers working in the area.

Re-stumping, like all structural work, needs to be undertaken by registered building practitioners.

If you are doing any structural work to a building, then the builder or tradesperson must be registered, regardless of the cost of the work, and you will require a building permit.
