# Another Our Region-Our Rivers Project Begins

Works have commenced on the Charlton Riverfront Project.

The \$950,000 project is funded by the Federal Government's Regional Growth Fund (Our Region-Our Rivers), Council and the community and will take advantage of the Avoca River running through the Charlton township and will link the CBD with the river and adjacent parks.
