

Notice of an Application for a Planning Permit

The land affected by the application is located at 7 Orr Street, Charlton.

The application is for a permit for the demolition of an existing dwelling and construction of a new dwelling.

The applicant for the permit is Ronald White.

The application reference number is PPA 835/20.

You may look at the application and any documents that support the application at the office of the Responsible Authority, Buloke Shire Office, Wycheproof.

This can be done during office hours and is free of charge. Any person who may be affected by the granting of the permit may object or make other submissions to the Responsible Authority.

An objection must be sent to the Responsible Authority in writing, include the objectors name and contact details, include reasons for the objection, and state how the objector would be affected. An objection form is available on the Planning and Building page of the Buloke Shire Council website.

The Responsible Authority will not decide on the application before 12 February 2020.

If you object the Responsible Authority will tell you its decision.

Load Limit Reduction

A load limit reduction was recommended for the Glenloth Bridge following a Level 3 Bridge Inspection.

The Load Limit is now set at 23 Tonne with signage being put in place either side of the bridge on Glenloth Road on the approach from Glenloth near Charlton-Glenloth road and near the Glenloth Road and Jeruk River Road intersection.
