Developments Underway Sea Lake:

Works are scheduled to commence along the south side of Best Street this week, with the removal and replacement of the footpath to match the existing rejuvenated footpaths.

Access will be maintained for customers to access businesses along the street and works completed in sections to minimise any inconvenience. New inclusions: plantings within the park areas, a new BBQ area and plenty of grass to sprawl out on, lay back and look at the clouds on those lazy days. Hours of work will be 7am-5.30pm Monday to Friday, until complete.

A planning permit has been approved for vegetation removal from 110 Sutcliff Street, Sea Lake, as part of a housing redevelopment. All required carbon offsets have been processed, with tree lopping services being arranged. Approximately 65 large-to-medium trees will be removed along with some smaller groups of saplings and shrubs.







Road Upgrade

Regional Roads Victoria are upgrading the Birchip-Rainbow Rd and Mcloughlans Rd intersections west of Birchip to improve safety and visibility as vehicles enter or exit the highway. Plan ahead as changed traffic conditions will be in place during works.
