- Donald Waste Transfer Station: Depot RD Donald

- Sea Lake Landfill: Robinvale RD Sea Lake
- Wycheproof Waste Transfer Station: 281 Mackies RD Wycheproof

Buloke Playspaces Trail

We are pleased to provide an update on ongoing projects across Berriwillock, Birchip, Donald and Wycheproof.

In Birchip, the new pool fence is complete and irrigation works are underway with landscaping and furniture installation to commence in late April. Please note that the water play area equipment delivery is expected in mid-late June which will allow works in the park to be completed.

In Berriwillock, irrigation work will commence in late-April followed by grass and plant installation. The basketball area shelter is set for installation by mid-May, with the rebound wall, basketball court slab and fencing to follow shortly after.

In Donald, concrete paths are complete. Drainage, irrigation and landscaping works are all underway, fencing will be installed to complete the works around the end of May.

In Wycheproof, concreters will commence on remaining footpaths in early April to ensure the park is ready for the ANZAC Day service, with irrigation and landscaping to follow.
