Charlton Solar Information Meeting

For anyone thinking about 'going solar' or adding battery storage on their home or business, there's an opportunity to learn more at a community information meeting at the East Charlton Hotel on Tuesday 24 February from 6.00-7.30pm.

Hosted by the not-for-profit Central Victorian Greenhouse Alliance – and in partnership with Central Goldfields Shire Council — this meeting will provide attendees with the information they need to decide whether now's a good time to get solar installed or to invest in a battery.

Cr Vis, Deputy Mayor of Buloke Shire Council, will open the meeting. Presenters are from solar & battery bulk-buy — Mallee Sun Solar Bulk-Buy — which is owned and organised by the Central Victorian Greenhouse Alliance.

Mallee Sun Solar Bulk-Buy aims to encourage the uptake of more solar in the region, helping residents cut their electricity bills and reduce CO2 emissions. Community groups benefit with one percent of bulkbuy revenues distributed to not-for-profit groups in each shire in the form of free solar.
