Buloke Libraries Get Ready to Roll

Buloke Shire Council has taken delivery of the vehicle that will play a central role in the direct delivery of library services from 1 July 2018. The van was fully funded by a State Government Living Libraries grant.

The van is equipped with an easy to operate lift at the rear of the vehicle to ensure safe and practical loading and unloading of the library stock to be taken across the Shire each week.

The delivery comes on the back of a so far successful recruitment phase for library staff, which has generated many high quality applicants. The vehicle is all but ready to roll with just some finishing touches including badging to be finalised.

“It is very exciting to see the physical features of our direct library service start to materialise. This vehicle will be a great asset for Council and community and will be a terrific resource for our Library Officer and Library Early Years Officer who will be appointed soon”, said Mayor Cr David Pollard.
