New Projects

Consultation will soon commence for feedback from the community regarding improvements to footpaths and crossings in Buloke. This is to improve safety and accessibility in busy areas.

In Nullawil, drainage works will be undertaken to improve stormwater run off on the western side of the Calder Highway.

Water supply connections will be installed to Buloke's aerodromes and the Watchem Oval. Council administers five airstrips across Buloke, with piped water improving fire safety for surrounding properties.

Council will advise of any community impacts in advance of works commencing.
