Emergency Management

Buloke management teams have commenced a new round of training for emergencies, which is part of ongoing preparation for future crisis management and community support.

These events include floods, fires, and agricultural threats such as disease outbreaks in animals and crops. The course reviews the roles played by different staff and their managerial responsibilities during events, resources available, and the interpretation of advice from State and Federal authorities.

Further training in October will focus on the set up of relief centres, the management of Council systems and administration during such critical times.

By-Election Timeline

Voters who were correctly enrolled for the Buloke Shire Mallee Ward as at 4pm on Friday 19 August will receive a ballot pack, which must be completed and returned by mail as soon as possible using the reply-paid envelope provided.

Ballot packs will be mailed from Tuesday 27 September and voters can vote by mail or can also hand-deliver their completed ballot papers to the election office located at 370 Broadway, Wycheproof on weekdays from Monday 10 October to Friday 14 October 2022. Office hours are from 9am to 5pm, with extended hours on Thursday 13 October (9am to 8pm) and Friday 14 October (9am to 6pm).

Voting closes at 6pm on Friday 14 October, with results available from Monday 24 October 2022.

Election Manager John Lyons advises voters to vote well ahead of the closing time.
