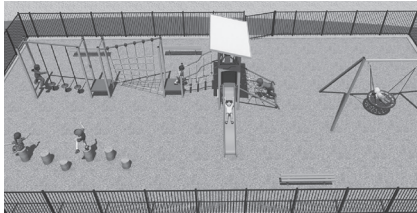
## Buloke | Glass Out

## Playspaces Trail - Wycheproof Update

Council has awarded contracts for the installation of a playground and BBQ shelter at Wycheproof and is also close to a final design for the skatepark. Once the final design is confirmed, Council will order the pump track then finalise a civil design for its installation and the concrete infill before locking in a contractor to assemble.



## Notice of an Application for a Planning Permit

The land affected by the application is located at **5 Byrne Street, Donald Vic 3480**. The application is for a permit for the construction of a kitchen, verandah, deck, and amenities and associated works for a restaurant, a reduction in the number of required car parking spaces, and the use of land to sell or consume liquor. The application reference number is PA23025.

You may look at the application and any documents that support the application on the **Buloke Shire Council website** or by making contact with the office of the Responsible Authority, **Buloke Shire Office, Wycheproof**. This can be done during office hours and is free of charge. Any person who may be affected by the granting of the permit may object or make other submissions to the Responsible Authority.

An objection must be sent to the Responsible Authority in writing, include the objectors name and contact details, include reasons for the objection, and state how the objector would be affected. An objection form is available on the Planning and Building page of the Buloke Shire Council website. The Responsible Authority will not decide on the application before **Friday 22 September 2023**. If you object the Responsible Authority will tell you it's decision.
